



Student Art Program

Submission Guidelines

1. Art Specialists are invited to submit a **maximum of 30 pieces** by their students. New York City public school students in 6th-12th grade are eligible. Work should be connected to the Winter 2012 theme, “**Goals and Dreams.**”
2. **Student Application Form**
Each work of art must be accompanied by its own completed Student Application Form downloadable at www.artsconnection.org/sections/schools/SAP. Art Specialists PLEASE make sure forms are filled out completely.
 - Parent/Guardian name and HOME address is REQUIRED information so that we can communicate directly with the students whose work is chosen about their choice of award.
 - Please make sure the completed forms are LEGIBLE.
 - The artist statement is required. It helps us greatly to understand more about the artwork, and is read during the selection process.
 - Please tape the completed form to the back of the work (no glue, staples or paper clips!).
3. **Student Artwork Specifications**
 - Work can be a maximum of 36 x 46”, flat artwork - frameable and hangable only.
 - Work in **any frameable medium** is welcomed- photography, painting, collage, printmaking
 - If the work contains objects (i.e. collage) attached by rubber cement, glue or other adhesives, please make sure it is secure. The art will be handled and moved around in the selection process. We are not responsible for damage due to fragility.
 - Pastels, charcoal or cray-pas must be well fixed and have cover paper to avoid smudging.
4. **Packing and Submitting the artwork**
 - Pack work carefully and surround with cardboard as you would like it to be returned. Please deliver (Mon-Fri, 9-5) or ship by

Return of Artwork: ArtsConnection will return the unselected work to the school. Selected artworks will be framed and exhibited for approximately **one year**. There will be an opening reception to which students, teacher and families are invited, and after that, students may visit their work by appointment through the Student Art Program Coordinator. If a student needs artwork for college applications, etc, before the end of the exhibition, the student or teacher may make arrangements with Student Art Program Coordinator. At the end of the exhibition, the framed work will be returned to the student care of the school. If the student is graduating, we will contact the student at the address provided on the form submitted with the work of art. It is the student’s responsibility to notify us of change of address.
